SENIORS: CLASS OF 2010 COLLEGE ACCEPTANCES

Seniors, as you receive your offers of admission from colleges and universities, be sure to contact each school that has offered you admission by May 1st to tell them yes or no. Letting a school know that you will not attend opens the available spot for a student who has been put on the wait list.

SDSU ADMISSIONS UPDATE

If you have applied to SDSU check your RedID for any instructions you need to complete. All acceptance responses should have been received. For those planning to attend Fall 2010, respond by May 1st. If you plan to live on campus, submit housing preferences by May 1st. For those not admitted, you may qualify for the Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program at a Community College. If you were not admitted, but offered the Wait List option, respond via your WebPortal ASAP to let them know you would like to be on the Wait List. You will know the 2nd week of May if you will be admitted. SDSU received 61,800 applications for 6,158 spots: 3534 undergraduate and 2624 transfer students. The 2010 freshman class average GPA is 3.78 with an average SAT score of 1148. Local freshman applicants were given extra eligibility index points for additional preference in the admissions process.

Be sure to apply online. 24 hours after applying, log on and sign up for an appointment to take the placement tests for math and English. This is required of all incoming freshman and must be completed prior to receiving your schedule.

SAT/ACT TESTING
