JR/SR HIGH ORIENTATION

LOCKERS for all grades will be made by random computer assignment. **DO NOT** switch or trade lockers. The number of your locker is located at the top of your schedule and is recorded in the office under your name. PE lockers will be assigned in PE classes after school starts. **Please contact the office if you have an issue with your locker.**

SCHOOL PICTURES will be taken on registration day. The enclosed picture envelope and money must accompany each student at the time of registration in order to purchase pictures. Be sure to wear your dress code shirts/blouses.

Guys: no facial hair, no earrings, and have your hair cut to meet dress code guidelines. **SENIORS** – Only in dress code if replacing an ID card.

ID CARDS All new 7th graders and any other new students must have an I.D. picture taken at registration. Seniors, if you are planning to replace your ID, please come in uniform. Any other student who would like to replace their current I.D. with a new one must bring in their old one and trade it in. It is free of charge when you turn in your existing I.D. card, but there is a charge of \$3.00 to replace it or if you replace it after registration.

PARKING All students who drive to school **MUST** park their cars on campus and have a permit. Bring the enclosed parking agreement with the \$20.00 fee on registration day. It must be completed and signed by a parent. You will then receive a parking permit. Parking places will be assigned this year, so it is very important to take care of this at registration. Spaces are assigned on a first come-first served basis. There is no student parking on Madison Avenue.

SUMMER SCHOOL

If you have successfully completed a summer school class, be sure that your transcript is sent to Christian High School so that we can add the course work to your CHS transcript. If the course you took over the summer will replace a class you are signed up to take this fall, let the Counseling Office know so your schedule can be corrected. PE UNIFORMS All 7th graders and new students must purchase their PE uniforms from Educational Outfitters. Returning students may continue to use their current PE uniform.

MATH STUDENTS

1. Book Covers

All students are required to have covers on their math books. The books are oversized so please be careful when purchasing stretchy book covers.

2. Calculators

Jr High – In general, calculators are not used at this level. Teachers will indicate when they are to be used. When they are used, a simple scientific calculator is fine. These can be purchased at Walmart, etc. and run about \$10-\$15.

Alg. 2 & above- Please supply your student with a Texas Instrument Graphing calculator. If they already have a TI-83, that will be fine. If you are purchasing a new calculator please get a TI-84 Plus. This will serve your students' needs into college level math and science courses. Costco and Walmart usually have the best prices. Please save the UPC label. TI gives CHS teaching tools if we collect the UPC labels. It saves us hundreds of dollars and makes us better equipped to help your student
