

# Junior High Supplies List 2010

## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade

Math: 1 spiral notebook (\*Specific requirements for the notebook on line below)

\*5 ✂MEAD brand, 3-holed, 2 pocket dividers, college-ruled, 120 pg., perforated, 8.5" x 11"

Science: A 1" 3-Ring Binder, 5 tab-dividers (For projects, to be turned in on the 1<sup>st</sup> day)

English: 1 PeeChee folder

History: A 1" 3-Ring Binder, 30 Sheet Protectors

Bible: Supplies are covered in the "All Classes" Portions

## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

Science: 1 spiral notebook (same as 7<sup>th</sup> grade math class)

Math: 1 calculator (with square root & exponent calculations), 1 spiral notebook (same as 7<sup>th</sup> grade math)

English, History, and Bible: Supplies are covered in the "All Classes" Portions

3. Students will need to replenish "All Classes" supplies as needed.

Also, Costco has, in the past, had a 3-pack for \$10 of the specific math/science spiral notebooks.
