

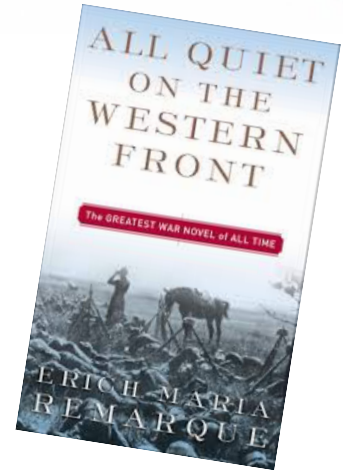
Summer Reading
