What is AirPlay?

AirPlay allows you to play media from your iPod, iPad, or MacBook over your projector, wirelessly, via AppleTV. You can also mirror the display of your device over the projector.

How Do I Turn on AirPlay on a MacBook?

1. Connect to the SMM-Staff wireless network
2. Click on the AirPlay icon in the menu bar at the top of the screen 
3. Select the AppleTV name that matches your room number
4. Enter the passcode, if requested (it will be displayed on the projection screen)
5. **When finished, make sure you go back to AirPlay, and choose "Disconnect AirPlay Display"**

How Do I Turn on AirPlay on an iPad?

1. Connect to the SMM-Staff wireless network
2. Swipe up from the bottom of the iPad
3. Tap AirPlay 
4. Select the AppleTV name that matches your room
5. Enter the passcode, if requested (it will be displayed on the projection screen)
6. **When finished, make sure you go back to AirPlay, and tap "iPad"**

How Do I Mirror My Display on a MacBook?

After selecting the AppleTV that matches your room number, go back to AirPlay, and click on "Mirror Built-in Display".

How Do I Mirror My Display on an iPad?

After selecting the AppleTV that matches your room number, slide the switch next to the word “Mirroring”.
