A NOTE ABOUT FUNDRAISING

Tuition and fees provide only a portion of the total cost required to educate a student at Christian Unified Schools of San Diego. CUSSD does not participate in student sales activities (ie: candy sales), but does conduct fund-raising campaigns (jog-a-thon, auction, Annual Fund), and asks that each family make contributions to the school as their circumstances allow.
